Re: Central Shenandoah Valley All Hazards Mitigation Plan

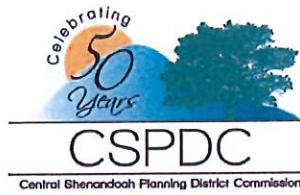
Dear Mr. Paxton,

The Central Shenandoah Valley All Hazards Mitigation Plan, first created in 2005 and last updated in 2013, describes and analyzes natural hazards like winter storms, drought, hurricanes, wildfires, and floods that impact our region and offers mitigation options to reduce the impact of these natural disasters on our citizens, businesses, infrastructure and property.

The Central Shenandoah Planning District Commission will be leading a multi-jurisdictional Steering Committee to update the Central Shenandoah Valley All Hazards Mitigation Plan beginning in the Spring of 2019. The update of this Plan, which will include all 21 jurisdictions in our region, will allow the opportunity to assess risk and vulnerability to natural and man-made hazards and to complete mitigation strategies to strengthen our region's communities.

The federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA2K) requires that local governments develop and adopt hazard mitigation plans in order to receive hazard mitigation grant funds in the future. In order to be eligible for future disaster funding, each local jurisdiction in our region must:

1. Appoint at least one person and one alternate to the Steering Committee. The appointee or their alternate must attend all three scheduled Steering Committee meetings. The first Steering Committee meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, April 3, 2019 at the BRITE Transit Facility in Fishersville. Additional meetings will be scheduled for June and October.
2. Adopt the Plan once it has been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).
