

**DAYTON TOWN COUNCIL
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MINUTES
June 19, 2018**

A motion by Zack Fletchall to change the July 9, 2018 council meeting to July 2, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. was seconded by Shelley Newman and passed unanimously by Council by roll call vote. Those in favor: (Long, Collier, Daly, Daily, Fletchall, Newman & Worthy).

MOVED, TO CHANGE THE July 9, 2018 MEETING TO July 2, 2018 at 6:00p.m.
